The Florida State Collection of Arthropods (FSCA) along with the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Plant Industry (FDACS-DPI) in Gainesville is announcing the availability of half-time (20 hours/week) and full-time positions working in the insect collection. The FSCA's holdings recently surpassed 12.5 million specimens and is growing by >100,000 specimens each year. Over recent decades, the FSCA has focused on expanding its collection holdings and maintains the best representation of the southeast USA and the largest dragonfly and damselfly collection in the world. We are seeking to expand our staff to actively improve the collections and digitize them for broader use.
