

CARBON COUNTY 4-H/FFA BREEDING BEEF/DAIRY CATTLE FORM

Due May 15th to the Extension Office. Please use one form per animal.

Photo Instructions – Include **two** color photos of your breeding animal with this form. One side photo showing any distinguishing marks, as well as one from the top OR front that show your animals tag number/tattoo.

Acceptable identification includes RFID Tag, Bangs Tag, Bangs Tattoo.

Other Rules & Expectations for Breeding Cattle –

- Breeding beef/dairy cattle must be owned by and in possession by the exhibitor as of January 1 of the current year.
- Proof of bangs vaccination (either metal ear tag, RFID, tattoo, or signed certificate from veterinarian) at check in.
- Breeding beef/dairy cattle will be shown by age and sex only; all breeds will be combined.
- Only one animal can be entered in each lot except cow/calf pair. Cow/calf pair cannot then be separated and re-entered additional classes.
- Miniature beef maximum hip height for females is 45” and 48” for males and will be shown by age and sex.
- All bulls being shown must be under 2 years of age.
