

CARBON COUNTY 4-H/FFA BREEDING SHEEP/GOAT FORM

Due May 15th to the Extension Office. Please use one form per animal.

Photo Instructions – Include **two** color photos of your breeding animal with this form. One side photo showing any distinguishing marks, as well as one from the top OR front that show your animals tag number/tattoo.

Acceptable identification include Scrapie Tags, Bangs Tattoo, or Microchip.

Other Rules & Expectations for Breeding Sheep/Goat-

- Breeding sheep/goats must be owned by and in possession by the exhibitor as of May 1 of the current year.
- Breeding sheep/goats will be shown by age and sex only; all breeds will be combined.
- Breeding sheep/goats entered as breeding stock cannot be shown as market animal.
- Breeding sheep/goats may not be tagged for another fair.
- All breeding sheep/goats must be tagged with a USDA scrapie tag. Tattoos and microchips are also acceptable methods of proof.
