*Part IV of a continuing series of student panel workshops*

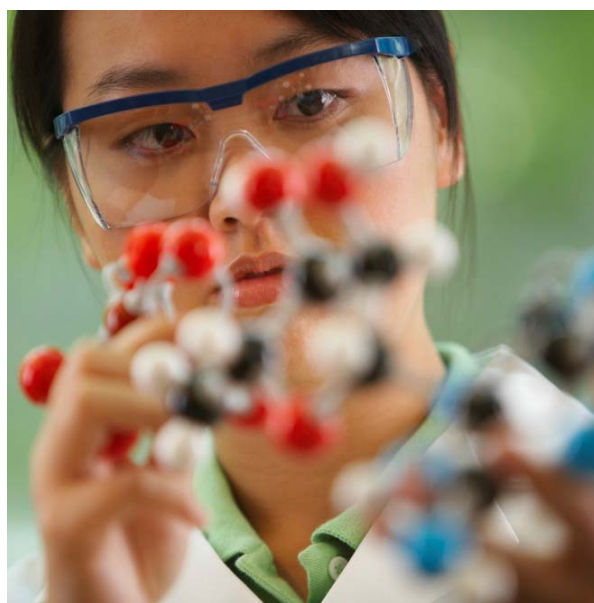
