
- Go to <u>ArcGIS Pro 3.1</u>
 (If you are having access issues with the above link, you need to log into MSU's Sharepoint with your NetID, see step #2.)
- 2. Log into MSU's Sharepoint with your NetID@msu.montana.edu and password.
- 3. Authenticate with Duo.
- 4. Install ArcGISPro_31_184994.exe, and the cumulative patch *314* (in file the filename) and higher.
 - a. ArcGIS ProHelp 31 185018.exe is optional.
 - b. Other files are unnecessary for student use.
 - c. If you encounter a .NET error during the ArcGIS Pro installation as below,



1. go to Microsoft's dotnet site to download and install .Net.

- 3. Download and install the x64. See the next image.









2. In Your ArcGIS organization's URL, enter **sscmsu**. Check the Remember this URL. Check the blue Continue button. See next image.




3. Click on the Spatial Sciences Montana State University ArcGIS Online Single Sign On.




4. Enter your NetId and password. Click Login.
